Carnivals In Somerset Promotion Project

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The Carnivals In Somerset Promotion Project (CISPP) was formed early in 2009 by a small group of carnival folk who were very concerned that the unique heritage of our Somerset Illuminated Carnivals could be lost in the future unless efforts were made to encourage more people to take part.

CISPP can offer primary schools an exhibition showing how carnivals evolved in our part of the world. We can tell the story of the history of our carnivals beginning with Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder Plot of 1605.

- We can tell the history of your local carnival covering how people all over England welcomed back the troops from the First World War.
- We can talk about having fun at today's carnivals covering the safety aspects of why the barriers are there and why we should stay behind them. Who are the people wearing bright yellow jackets and what they do, when and where we should throw our coins and the consequences of running out into the road to pick up coins that have missed the collection vehicles.
- We can bring boxes of hats, wigs and costumes for dressing up
- We can take two classes per morning or afternoon session.
- **In a morning session** we can have two classes for one hour each class. We will start with a short 10minute introduction. The first class will be split into 3 groups, where each group will have 20 minutes dressing up, 20 minutes in the van watching a specially produced DVD for schools and 20 minutes looking at how costumes are made with a costume maker and masquerader. After a SHORT break we can do the same with the second class. Then finishing with a 10 minute question and answer session with both classes.
- **In an afternoon session starting at 1pm**, we would have the same format approximately 1 hour per class but with a few minutes of introduction and without the question and answer session at the end.

We would need the hall for dressing up and a separate room for the looking at costumes. If there a fewer classes we can tailor the session to suit the school's needs.

A member school staff must be with all groups at all times.
