


#### **Iconic Carnival Carts** (1982-2016)

This film celebrates five decades of the Somerset carnivals. Featuring around 75 carts compiled from archive footage from, this updated and revised DVD shows the most innovative and iconic carts seen in our carnivals. With introductions to each chapter by Dr Andrew Tallon, this film also explains the social history of carnivals and the development of carnival carts from simple trailers to the extravaganzas of the present day.

#### **Walking Your Way Into Carnival** (1985-2014)

This DVD celebrates the heritage and development of masquerading participants in the West Country illuminated carnival processions, and the evolution of juvenile walkers into carnival clubs. The film features archive carnival footage and new interviews with masquerading participants.


## Cirque de Fun (2003-2018)




#### A Celebration Of Bygone Clubs Of Past Eras (1985-2019)

This unique archive footage of bygone clubs is presented as originally featured on official videos/DVDs. It represents 94 bygone carnival clubs that have folded over the last four decades. This is over twice as many cart clubs that exist in the carnival today. This is many more clubs than imagined, so rather than omit any, we present the complete range of clubs totalling 653 different carts from 1985-2019. This film covers four carnival decades in five chapters and captured on a USB memory stick which can be viewed on computers/laptops (PCs/Macs) and modern televisions using the USB port on these devices.
